Student Resources




Examples Of Service Entity Resources:

- Project expenses or assets provided by the service entity to support your project
- The opportunity to evaluate the mission of the service entity organization
- Likely connects to non-profit organizations that are serving a population related to their mission
- Examples include: Food Bank organizations, community organizations or other related entities
